New Life (and other) Masters

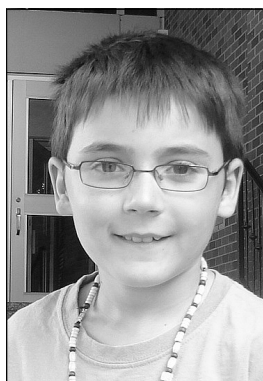
Barb Landry made the grade last night in the second session of the Bracketed Knockouts. She was playing with Alverna Simpson on a team with Doug Hamilton and
