## Provincial and Club News

**Bridgewater DBC** was formed April 19 1969. The first president was Max Olive who was also the first Life Master. The first Sectional Tournament was held Sept,5-6-7 in 1969. In 1982 the club moved to the current location Days Inn. First Gold Life Master is Edgar Blinn. The Club has 2 regular games weekly, Monday, and Wednesday night plus we also play special games. Both Martha Ramey and Patsy Timbrell who are original members still play regularly in our club.

**The Moncton Duplicate Bridge Club** has launched an initiative to reverse a dwindling membership trend. It's a two-pronged program, combining lessons with an opportunity for newcomers to play at their own pace in a non-intimidating environment.

The club offered three courses starting in the fall of 2011, with Marilyn MacDiarmid leading an introductory course, followed by Bridge Basics II Competitive Bidding, and Common Conventions, given by Anne Posch and Jon Shute.

"These classes were very successful with 24 to 28 participants," says club president Connie Bartlett. "A newcomers game has started on Thursday mornings, with the numbers attending ranging from 31 to 36. We provide a short teaching session prior to playing, as well as club members for partners if needed, so that everyone gets to play. The feedback from the group has extremely positive. Some of these players have started to attend the club's regular game on Monday afternoon."
