CANADIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS TO BE HELD IN HALIFAX

CAN-AT 2000 ALSO PART OF FESTIVAL OF BRIDGE

This year the CNTC, CWTC and COPC National Finals will be played in Halifax as part of the **Halifax 2000 FESTIVAL OF BRIDGE** which will also include CAN-AT 2000.

CBF Bridge Week will be held at the Lord Nelson Hotel from June 22 - 29, 2000.

This is an excellent opportunity for our Maritime players to participate in our National Championships since travel expenses to Halifax are minimum compared to other Canadian venues.

We are encouraging all clubs to hold qualifying games for the CNTC (Open Teams), CWTC (Women's Teams) and the COPC (Open Pairs). Qualifying games may be held any time from September 1999 to Mid-January 2000.

This year the CNTC Unit Final format has been changed. Each of the following Unit Final areas may qualify teams to produce 14 teams for the Zone Final.

St. John's (2), Cape Breton (2), Halifax (3), Moncton (2), Newcastle (3), and Charlottetown (2). In the event that an area does not produce its quota for the Zone Final, additional qualifiers will be taken from the sites that had the greatest participation.

We expect to be able to field four (4) teams in the CNTC National Finals this year. In addition, if one of the other zones does not send its quota of teams, additional local teams may be qualified to fill these spaces. There are 28 teams from across Canada that compete in the CNTC final.

The Zone Final of the CWTC will be held in March or April 2000.

The Canadian Open Pairs Championship will be held June 28 - 29. The first day is a two session qualifying with the Final and consolation on the 29. There are cash prizes for the top placing pairs in the COPC. You can qualify to participate in the COPC by qualifying at your local club. Players who compete in the CNTC and CWTC

also qualify to participate in the COPC.

CAN-AT 2000 will also be part of the **FESTIVAL OF BRIDGE**. The CAN-AT will be played in the World Trade and Convention Centre June 28 - July 3, 2000.

Advertisements for the **FESTIVAL OF BRIDGE** appear in this issue following **UPCOMING TOURNAMENTS**.

All players are reminded to make reservations early for these Bridge activities as Hotel space for summer 2000 in Halifax is limited. ☺

GRAND NATIONAL TEAMS FLIGHTS B and C

The District 1 Final of the Grand National Teams flights B and C will be held during the Quebec City Regional in October.

The Flight C District Final will be held on Sunday, October 10, beginning at 1:00 pm.

The Flight B District Final will be held on Monday, October 11 beginning when the regular game starts. The game on the last day of a tournament generally starts earlier.

Flight B is limited to players with less than 1500 master points. Winners of these events are eligible to play in the North American Finals in Anaheim, CA in 2000.
